### V-500 Responds to Economic Downturn

The downturn in the markets over the past year have impacted almost every entity in our society. Folks on a fixed income have felt the pinch of reduced earnings. Businesses and indeed charitable organizations have also felt the impact. Your V-500 Scholarship program is no exception. Over the years, we have increasingly become dependent on interest income to supplement our scholarship allocations. The absence of that income for the current academic year placed considerable pressure on our ability to sustain our commitment to the students of VCSU.

The VCSU Foundation allocates a total of \$660,000 annually to the students of VCSU. Those dollars come from a combination of annual contributions and investment income. Of that amount approximately \$200,000 comes from V-500. Thanks to our V-500 reserves, the foundation was fortunate to be positioned to turn to V-500 to make up the difference caused by the loss of interest income in the investment pool. Without that reserve, we would have been forced to reduce our commitment to our students. That is something we were very reluctant to do. Although the markets are coming back, they still have a long ways to go to get back to where they were at their peak. As a result, we are in a very challenging position once again. We have exhausted our reserves. We now must make a commitment to our Enrollment Services staff now so they are positioned to offer scholarships to students for the 2010-2011 academic year.

Can we count on you for your continued support of V-500? If you are a current member, thank you for your support. Please consider increasing your annual commitment. If you are not a member, please consider a membership today. Membership in V-500 is an investment in our students, our university and our community! There are a variety of membership levels from which to choose. Some folks prefer auto pay via their Visa or Mastercard. Others prefer regular billing from our office either quarterly, semi annually or annually.

There are some attractive tax advantages for making a Year End Gift to V-500. By doing so, you not only benefit our scholarship program, but you can also deduct your contribution on your 2009 tax return. The VCSU Foundation is a 501 3C organization as classified by the Internal Revenue Service. As always, we advise you to consult with your Tax Accountant to determine the impact on your personal situation. 


