The V-500 Board of Directors recently held their annual kick-off meeting. This is the meeting that marks the start of a new campaign and election of officers. Katie Sather was elected President, with Jenny Enger accepting the position of Vice President. This year, the board has set a goal to raise \$75,000. The Board of Directors are hard-working volunteers that care about what VCSU has done for them and the community. V-500 Celebrates 40 Years

V-500 is celebrating 40 years of its organizational existence. This is a great time to reflect on how this organization has evolved and shaped the success of Valley City State University. In 1972, visionary members of the community united to originate the first merit-based scholarship program at VCSU. Modeled after Concordia College's C-400 program, V-500 was born to assist quality students entering Valley City State University. The exemplary founders or members were President Howard Rose, Director Jim Martin, Orville Barber, John Carlisle, Art Dafoe, Calvin Foss, Bob Ingstad, Dorothy Langemo, Dean Lenaburg, Neil Macdonald, Curtis Olson, Carol Peterson, Willard Richman, Dale Sorenson, Jim Swanke and Janet Wick. Carol Peterson remembers, "It was an exciting and fun time (to launch the program). Concordia's C-400 members came to share their ideas with us, which was a big help. Janet Wick was the first to write a check to V-500! I was second. I had to run down to the chapel to ask Ty to write the check." she laughs.

The first year's pledges were structured in the amount of \$500, paid over five years. Scholarship awards were in the amount of \$75-\$125 each. Scholarship awards are now in the amount of \$1,500-\$5,000, while pledge levels range from \$1,000-\$5,000 over 4 years. The first year's total allocation reached \$5,000, which seems minimal compared to the \$250,000 allocation V-500 covered last year.

Since the birth of V-500, over 100 volunteers have come forward to serve on the V-500 Board of Directors. They have been prominent residents of Valley City and the surrounding area who share a common desire to support VCSU in time, talent and treasure. These volunteers have had strong leadership in Jim

Martin, Bob Horne, Luther Skogen and Larry Robinson, respectively. Volunteer efforts, coupled with the generosity of V-500 members have made this scholarship program strong, stable and recognizable. However, there is always room to expand. As VCSU's enrollment continues to grow, we are faced with challenges of increasing funds for V-500.

I am privileged to lead this historic program and carry on the legacy of V-500. The founders should be extremely proud of their far-sighted initiative that has flourished into a critical program for the success of recruiting quality students to Valley City State University.

The Impact of Your Gift



- V-500 Scholarships are awarded in amounts of \$1,500, \$2,500 and \$5,000 (\$2,500 renewable over 2 years)
- Full-year cost (ND residents) of tuition, fees, room and board exceeds \$11,000. This does not include books or personal costs.
- 96% of first-time freshmen qualified for financial aid last academic year
- 123 VCSU students benefited from V-500 scholarships in the 2011-2012 year
- It is no accident that recordbreaking enrollment occurred the same year as record-breaking scholarship allocations (2011)
