U.S. News 'Best College'

The 2015 US News & World Report's "Best Colleges" annual rankings were recently released. VCSU has been ranked as the #2 Public Regional College in the Midwest this year. This is VCSU's sixth consecutive year being ranked either #1 or #2 in this category, and no other college or university can make that claim. VCSU also remains the highest-rated North Dakota university ranked in the "Public Regional College in the Midwest" category for the sixth straight year.
