

It has been an honor to serve as your VCSU Alumni Board President this past year. I pass the gavel on to Gene Boyle for '98-'99.



## VCSU Fieldhouse To Get New Floor

The W.E. Osmon Building for Physical Education on the campus of Valley City State University, commonly known as the "bubble" will soon have a new floor in the arena. The present tartan surface, which was installed nearly 30 years ago has outlived its usefulness. According to Don Bauer, VCSU's Athletic Director, "the present floor has become a liability hazard, and is clearly beyond its life expectancy."

The new floor was made possible by an aggressive effort on the part of university personnel over the past 24 month time period. After months of planning, the university was successful late last fall in obtaining \$85,000 from the North Dakota State Board of Higher Education. Although the dollars from the Board of Higher Education provided the initial "seed" money for the new floor, the university needed an additional \$100,000 to complete the project which is expected to cost in excess of \$180,000.

The \$100,000 needed to complete the financial package came from a number of local and area businesses: Concrete Dakota, Coca Cola Bottling Co., Lafarge Dakota, Newman Signs, Norwest Bank, Tharaldson Enterprises, Valley Sales, Kadmas, Lee & Jackson, AgAir, and Foss Associates Architects.

Work on the project is already underway. Terry Gilbertson Construction, Valley City, was awarded the general contractor bid. The new wood floor is being installed by Anderson Ladd, Minneapolis, and is expected to be completed by early August.

## Memorial Gifts...A Gift That Keeps On Giving

All of us have special people who had, and continue to have, a significant impact on our lives. These individuals include our parents, grandparents, brothers, sisters, and other members of our family. The list also often includes teachers, coaches, and others who were positioned to influence our lives forever.

Many of us often wonder how we might do something special for these individuals to memorialize their name forever. One suggestion is to consider an endowed memorial scholarship. Such a scholarship is an outstanding way to provide a lasting memory for that special person in your life with a gift that keeps on giving.

This office has had the opportunity to work with several individuals over the past year who have established endowed memorial scholarships. The actual amount of the gift can vary, depending on the size of the scholarship you wish to establish. For example, a \$5,000 gift will provide an annual scholarship of up to \$500 for a student at the

university. A \$10,000 gift would provide either two scholarships up to \$500 each or a scholarship up to \$1,000. In either case, as the donor, you have the opportunity to decide the amount of the gift and the scholarship. In addition, we will work with you to draft a statement of intent which outlines the use of the scholarship and recognizes in a meaningful way that special person you wish to memorialize.

The examples above are intended to give you an idea on the many options available. The gift would be endowed and only the interest earnings would be used for the scholarship. The principal would be in place forever. It is also possible to structure the gift so each year, in addition to the scholarship allocation, the principal would experience some growth and allow for modest increases in the scholarship allocation in future years to keep up with inflation and the rising costs of education.

The Foundation office, in cooperation with

the university Financial Aid Office, on an annual basis publishes a booklet which includes a listing of all memorial scholarships. The listing includes the descriptive information about each scholarship, criteria for the scholarship, and information about the individual memorializes. Without a doubt, the endowed memorial scholarship is an excellent way to provide for a lasting memory of someone special in your life. It also becomes a gift that keeps on giving...today, tomorrow, and forever.



# VCSU Names 1998 Hall of Fame Inductees

Four athletes, a coach, and a football team constitute the 1998 class entering the Viking Hall of Fame at Valley City State University. Scheduled for induction at the Valley City State University Hall of Fame dinner and ceremony during Homecoming week on Friday, September 25, are Jack Ramey '61, James McPherson '59, Jennifer Bennett Conlon '87, Eric Jorgenson '80, the 1976 football team, and Jim Dew, who coached at VCSU from 1974-1993.

VCSU Athletic Director Don Bauer praised the 1998 Hall of Fame selections, "Once again we have a class of deserving individuals who had outstanding athletic careers at VCSU. The individual accomplishments of Jack Ramey, James McPherson, Jennifer Bennett Conlon, Eric Jorgenson, and the outstanding record of the 1976 football team along with the dedication of Jim Dew's coaching expertise are very deserving of induction into the Viking Hall of Fame."

## **Jack Ramey '61** **Kearney, NE**



Jack Ramey was a four year letterwinner in football. He played on one conference championship team in 1958 and was selected as Most Valuable Lineman in 1960. Jack was a two year letterwinner in wrestling and was a two time conference champion. He placed second in the 1961 NAIA national meet and wrestled on the conference championship team in 1961.


After his college career, Ramey coached wrestling for which he was inducted into the NAIA Hall of Fame in the field of coaching wrestling.

## **James McPherson '59** **Bismarck, ND**



Jim was a three year letterwinner in basketball. He was on three conference championship teams and was selected All-Conference in 1958 and 1959.

## **Eric Jorgenson '80** **Lacrosse, WI**



Eric was a three year letterwinner in football and a four year letterwinner in baseball. He was named All District in baseball in 1978 and All Conference in 1978 and 1979. In 1977, Eric was named All Conference in football and Honorable Mention All District. In 1978 he was named All Conference, All District, was named Top Defensive Player and was named to the NAIA Division II All American First Team Defense.

## **Jim Dew** **Valley City, ND**




Jim Dew coached football at VCSU from 1974-1993 and baseball from 1974-1991. Under his leadership, VCSU won five NDCAC championships in baseball along with a VCSU first-ever District 12 baseball championship in which the team advanced to the Area III Regional Tournament. Dew compiled a 275-329 baseball coaching record at VCSU.

Dew's Viking football team won eight NDCAC football championships and several of his teams were nationally ranked with the 1976, 1980, and 1988 teams

competing in the National Playoffs. Dew's VCSU career football coaching record as 116-65-2.

In 1980, Dew was named North Dakota Sports Media College Coach of the Year when his Vikings advanced to the NAIA National Semifinal game and finished as the fourth-rated team in the National Poll. Dew has also been inducted into the Mount St. Joseph High School Hall of Fame, the Mayville State Hall of Fame as an individual and team member, and into the VCSU Hall of Fame as coach of the 1977 Viking football team.

## **Jennifer Bennett Conlon '87** **Mandan, ND**



In 1985 she was named All Conference, All District, was 10th in the nation in blocking and was named District 12 Player of the Week two consecutive weeks. Student interns taught weekly lessons in the Piano Pedagogy Laboratory program, led by Dr. Diana Skroch. Donnie Tahrán is the new guitar teacher for the Community School of the Arts. Beth Gigante Klingenstein was named NDMTA Teacher of the Year at their annual convention. Sara Hagen's theory students used Rhapsody notation software and ear training software in the keyboard and computer lab. John Reed and Tim Farrell led the Choir and Wind Ensemble tour to Steele, Beulah, Watford City, and Alexander, ND, during October 1997. Margaret Dahlberg, Division of Communication Arts, began a string lessons program and directed the first VCSU Community School of the Arts Chamber Music Festival in November. Students and adult community people were members. The Christmas concert featured Handbells, directed by Beth Gigante Klingenstein, Concert Choir, and Wind Ensemble.

Martin Kelly, Division of Communication Arts, directed "Brigadoon". John Reed was the music director and Tim Farrell led the Wind Ensemble. Music faculty presented a faculty recital in March, with proceeds used for scholarships. The All-Star Percussion Ensemble, directed by John K. McBride, toured high schools in eastern North Dakota. In-service school librarians and teachers from all over North Dakota, as well as some librarians from Minnesota, South Dakota, and Montana, are enrolled in our Library Media & Information Science minor program. This summer we have North Dakota students from Anamoose, Ashley, Bismarck, Bowdon, Butte, Cando, Dickinson, Dodge, Eckelson, Eureka, Fargo, Fessenden, Fort Yates, Gilby, Glenfield, Goodrich, Grand Forks, Harvey, Hillcrest, Inkster, Jamestown, Kulm, Litchville, Mandan, Menoken, Minot, Pembina, Pingree-Buchanan, Scranton, Starkweather, St. John, Taylor, Turtle Lake, Valley City, Wahpeton, Williston, and Zealand as well as Brookings, South Dakota.

The professional staff at VCSU's Allen memorial Library teach these courses. Margaret Wieland is teaching the courses Administration of the School Library Media Center and Searching on the Web this summer. Kurt Meyer is teaching Cataloging and Classification and Darryl Podoll is teaching Media Collection Development as well as supervising the Library Practicum (an internship in our library and the Valley City-Barnes County Library).

North Dakota public schools need Department of Public Instruction certified librarians in order to gain accreditation points from the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools and the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction accreditors. These in-service teachers and librarians are extremely capable and professional. It is both fun and a challenge to teach them! We often say we learn as much from them as they do from us.

Valley City State University and Mayville State University are the only two institutions in the state that have Library Media & Information Science programs providing certified librarians for the public schools in North Dakota. During the school year, VCSU and MaSU are cooperating to offer a joint Library Media & Information program on the North Dakota Interactive Video Network (IVN).

Network limitations and the practicalities of teaching via distance education limit the number of sites to five at one time. Valley City and Mayville are always included, and Bismarck is usually a site. The two other sites, which receive courses on a two-year rotating basis (the length of time it takes to finish the program), have so far included Bottineau, Devils Lake, Grand Forks, Wahpeton and Williston. Offering our courses jointly on IVN during the school year makes our library programs available to in-service librarians and teachers who are place-bound and cannot come to our campuses during the summer.

This year the estate of Rosemond Cook established a Rosemond Cook Memorial Library Scholarship Fund of \$20,000, the interest from which will provide up to two \$1,000 scholarships to library students in 1998-99. The Friends of the Library (whose organizing committee currently consists of Roanne Masterson, Jolene Daede Baltrusch, Anne Haugaard, Ellen Kienitz, Lillian Jacobson, Laurence J. Kipp, and Darryl B. Podoll) have also been extremely active in raising scholarship money for our library students. At Homecoming this fall we will have our annual Friends of the Library Alumni Luncheon, which is held as a fund raiser for student scholarships, on Saturday, September 26th at 11:30<sup>AM</sup> in the Student Center (following the Homecoming Parade and before the game). Everyone is welcome to attend the luncheon!




